## Co-Curricular activities

Charges are variable and will be notified to parent/s by the Co-Curricular Department. All payments are due in sterling. Any costs of clearing non-sterling payments, or overseas cheques, will be charged to, and are payable by, parents.

## Additional charges

### Examination fees

All examination fees and related costs are charged to parents.

### Textbooks

The School normally provides textbooks up to and including I/GCSE level. However the cost of replacing books that have been annotated or are returned in poor condition will be charged to parents. Cambridge Pre-U and A Level textbooks are normally charged to parents.

### Field trips

The Biology and Geography Departments organise field trips for those girls taking public examinations in these subjects. Parents will be asked to make a contribution to the cost of these trips.

### Optional academic out-of-School activities

Parents will be asked to make a contribution to the cost of those academic activities in which their daughters take part but which are not compulsory.

### Hymn books

A charge of £23 will appear on the first fees invoice for hymn books. This is a 'one off' charge to cover the cost of wear and tear on the School's hymn books.

### Linen charge

A charge of £86 will appear on the first fees invoice for linen. This is a 'one off' charge to cover the cost of bed linen throughout a girl's stay at Downe House.

### House activities

Parents of girls who go on the various House activities will be asked to contribute towards any costs that are incurred as a result of the activity. The total amount charged in the term should not exceed the sum indicated to a girl's Housemistress at the beginning of each term unless parents have agreed to the additional cost beforehand in writing.

### Transport

Parents will be charged for the cost of providing transport for journeys:

- to and from the airport
- to and from the railway station
- for all medical or dental appointments
- any other trips requested by a girl and authorised by a member of her Housestaff.

**All payments are due in sterling. Any costs of clearing non-sterling payments or overseas cheques will be charged to and are payable by parents.**
